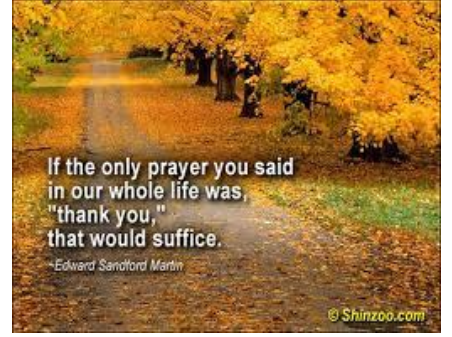

3. An adult wild turkey has 5500 feathers on their body including 18 tail feathers.

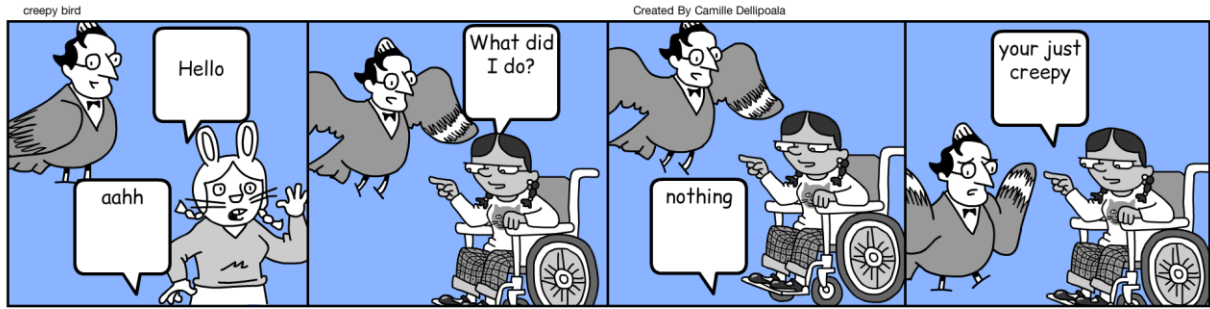

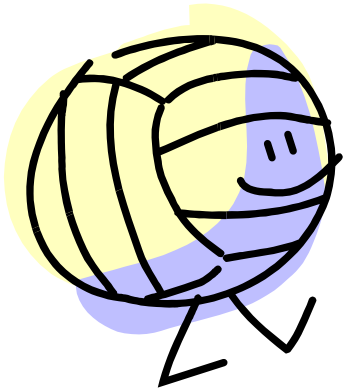

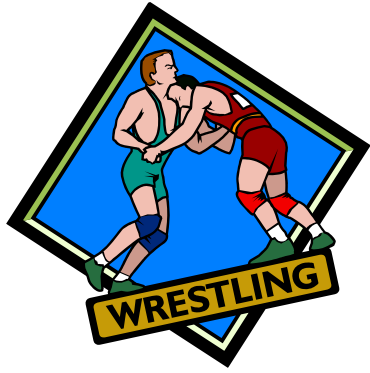
