Eligibility: Service club is open to all students in grades 7-12. It is possible to participate in both service club and other school activities.

Meetings: Meetings are generally held one Tuesday each month during lunch in the high school Bible room (room 303). Meeting dates are given at the meetings and via e-mail, the school website, Edline, and facebook.

Service Projects: We do an average of one service project each month, and they include a variety of both in-school and out-of-school activities. Most take place after school on Fridays, though a few are on Saturdays. Several examples from last year are raking leaves for the elderly, organizing a food drive, visiting a nursing home, and making sleeping bags for the homeless.

Also, if a student who is not in service club would like to be involved in a particular project, he may as long as he talks to me ahead of time so that I can make sure he receives all of the information concerning that project.
